Accreditation

I have received a number of applications for reaccreditation. Thank you to all those who have re-applied, and I appeal to anyone else whose accreditation has expired, to please do so.

There are 3 categories of accreditation, namely:

Accreditation Status	Required Score
Fully Accredited Professional	≥ 25 points

Associate Sports Medicine	15 – 24
Professional	points
Sports Medicine Professional in	10 - 14
Training	points

The application fee is R100 and a plaque displaying your status costs R300. Application available from forms are Arina Otto (gesal@ufs.ac.za) or myself, be or can downloaded from the SASMA website (www.sasma.org.za).

In a similar vein, please can I encourage you all to renew your SASMA membership for 2012. Application forms are also available on the SASMA website. South African Institute for Drug Free Sport

I recently met with Khalid Galant of SAIDS, and I have agreed to forward him a list of SASMA accredited sports physicians. The intention is also to load the list onto the SAIDS website to encourage athletes to visit SASMA sports physicians for their TUE needs. We are also working closely with him to develop a model for testing for anabolic steroids at schools.




Book Review
